Smoke-Free Environment

The Waterford Board of Education recognizes that tobacco in the school and work environments is not conducive to good health. As an educational organization, the District provides both effective educational programs and a positive example to students concerning the use of tobacco.

The Board declares all facilities operated by the Board, and all spaces within them, to be officially designated tobacco-free environments. Staff, students, and members of the public are prohibited from using tobacco in any form in school facilities.

Smoking is prohibited on school grounds and at any school activity.
