Interscholastic/Intramural Athletics

The Board of Education shall support interscholastic athletics at the high and middle school level. The Board subscribes to the rules and regulations of the Connecticut Interscholastic Athletic Conference Board of Control of the Connecticut Association of Secondary Schools (CAS) and the middle school level. Middle school interscholastic athletic activities shall be consistent with the guidelines developed by the Middle Level School Board of Control of CAS.

It is the Board's policy to provide interscholastic athletic competition for students in a variety of sports. Qualified and certified personnel shall be provided for coaching and supervision. Student participation shall be on the basis of medical approval, desire, parental permission, proper insurance coverage, academic and other eligibility under the rules of the appropriate CAS Board of Control. The Board encourages good sportsmanship.

The Board endorses intramural activities at the elementary, middle, and senior high school level.
