Homework/Make-Up Work/Assignments

Homework

Homework assignments are an integral part of the student learning process. Assignments appropriate to the course of study shall be given in quantity and degree of difficulty corresponding to the age, grade level, and ability of students. Assignments requiring the researching of information outside of the classroom and written reports are encouraged.

Homework assignments will not be given in advance for absences due to vacation.

Guidelines for homework assignments approved by the Superintendent of Schools shall be used in course lesson planning, course objectives, and shall be made available to students and their parents.

Individual Help

The Board directs the administration to develop and implement a program of extra-help instruction in all subject areas for those students who are in need of instruction in addition to that received in regular classroom.

Extra-help sessions shall in no way interfere with the regular classroom schedule of the student nor impose any undue hardship on the student, and shall not be construed as extra-credit or enrichment classes.

Administrators shall equalize extra-help duty among all teaching personnel.
