

Bylaws of the Board

Qualifications of Members

A Board of Education member must be a resident elector of the Town, that is, a registered voter in the Town. Therefore, he/she must be at least eighteen (18) years of age and a citizen of the United States.

Under State law, no member of the Board shall be employed for compensation in any position in the school system. Should a Board member be subsequently employed in the school system by the Town, his/her position on the Board shall become vacant.
